 We beg of convenient that by return of
 the Beavers you would send me 2 beaver
 traps

Your kind regards as a list of what
 the Beavers was paid for their traps before
 bearing for they said they would take the
 rest at present

we hope the Beavers speedily and safely
 reach their destination respectfully


